THE PARENTS' AGREEMENT - As a parent, I commit to:

2. Obtain and check out relevant textbooks required for appropriate courses from our campus.
3. Providing an environment that fosters learning with parental supervision and support.
4. Supporting the teachers and ensuring the completion of all homework assignments.
5. Participation in parent/teacher conferences, scheduled open houses and other school activities as needed.
6. Ensure my child respects all district policies.
7. Ensure that school has my most current contact information including personal number, work number, cell phone numbers and e-mail addresses.
8. Monitoring the amount of time my child spends playing video games, using the internet, using electronic devices and I will also commit to monitor the appropriateness of each.
9. Monitoring my child's academic progress and attendance regularly (Home Access Center), and requesting a parent- teacher conference as needed.
10. Teaching my child to respect his/her teachers and all other school personnel.
11. Keep an open line of positive communication with my child, teachers and administrators to be a proactive part of my child's education.
12. Review the progress reports that go home every 3 weeks, sign, and return them with dates. Request a teacher conference as needed.

THE TEACHER'S AGREEMENT - As a teacher, I commit to:
